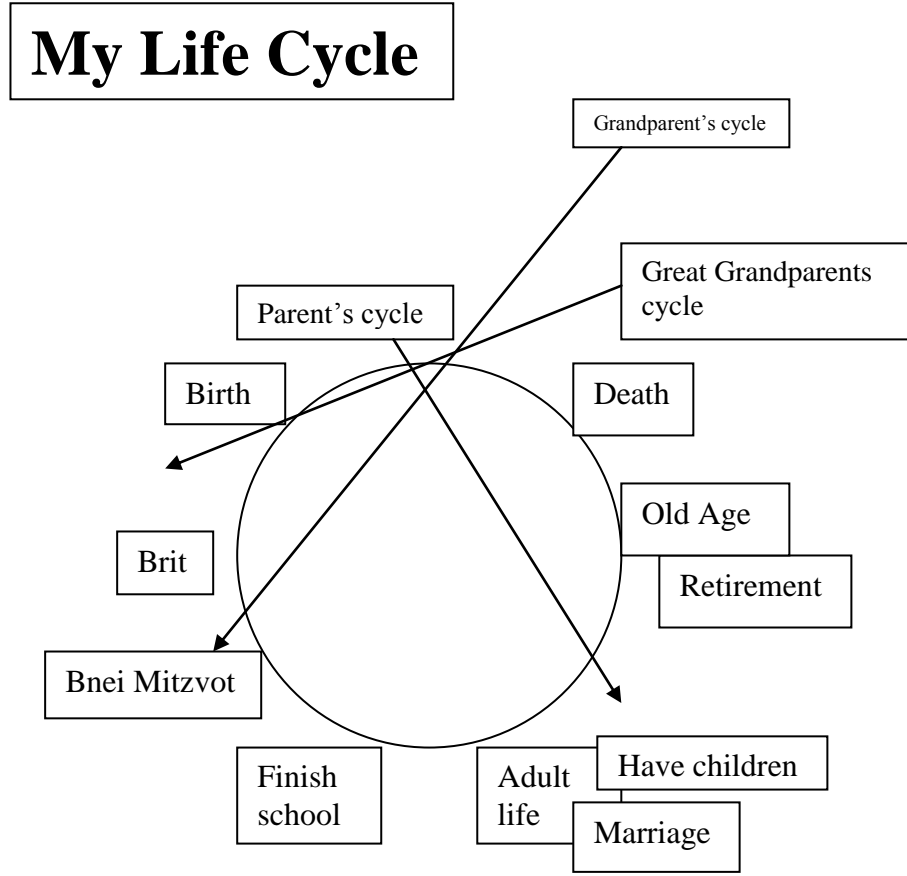


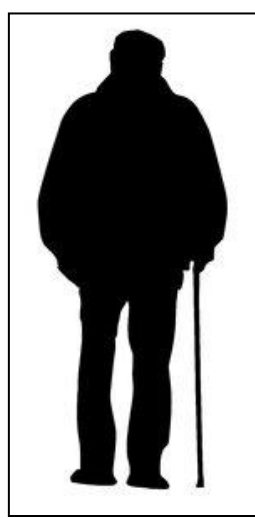
# T H E L I F E C Y C L E



Above is an example of a life cycle. It goes from birth to death and includes some of the key stages of life.



The lines amongst the circle show life lines. For example, the Great grandparents' life line may end just at the birth of this cycle; and one of the parent's life lines may end during adult life of this cycle.



This shows how life cycles are continuous and never ending. If children are born, they continue with a new life line of their own.
